The Leipzig Cohorts and Trial(ist)s LeiCoT program will address the high need for clinical trialists developing and conducting cohort studies and randomized controlled trials. LeiCoT will build on and extend the excellent infrastructure in the areas of Metabolism, Heart/Brain and Cancer at Leipzig University. LeiCoT will provide novel career pathways, excellent training, cutting-edge clinical research tools and long-term perspectives for clinical trialists to ultimately improve patient care. The program duration is six years, with an interim evaluation after 3 years.

- Recognized specialist (Facharzt) with a strong research background in basic, translational, or clinical research
- Strong research history in one of the three profile areas: Metabolism, Brain/Heart, or Cancer
- Demonstrated ability to establish, lead, and actively shape a research group
- Independent third-party funding acquisition is desirable
- German medical license (Approbation) or authorisation to practice medicine in Germany
- Strong publication record, typically  $\geq 6$  peer-reviewed original publications or at least one excellent publication (e.g. top 10% journal or impact factor  $> 15$ ) as first or last author
